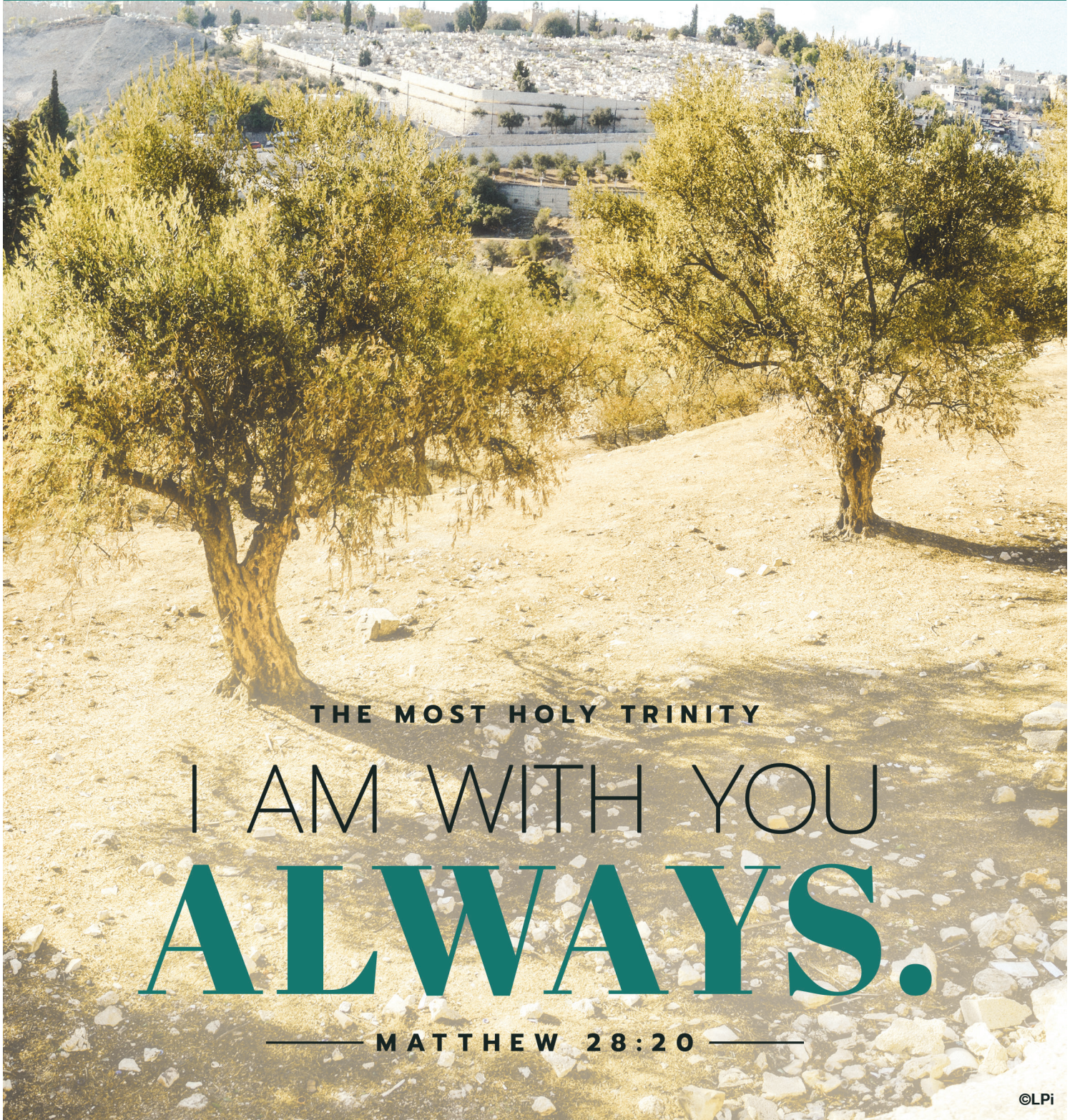

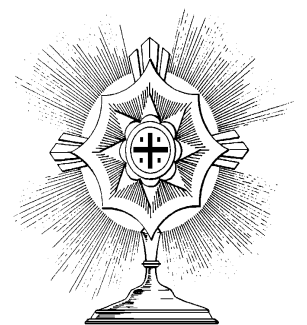
Baptism For more information, please visit the parish website. Baptism classes are generally held at 10am on the first Saturday of every month. Please call the office to register for class or register through the parish website.

If you have a time scheduled, please feel free to come to the church. He is available for about 20-30 minutes per person. However, he will make himself available for longer if needed. Spiritual Direction is a way to help an individual discern how the spirit is leading the person. The role of a spiritual director is not to direct attention to oneself, rather it is to help the directed focus on Christ and sort out confusion or obstacles. Confession is also available during these times. Please contact Fr. Jeff if you would like to schedule a time to meet with him contact the parish office.

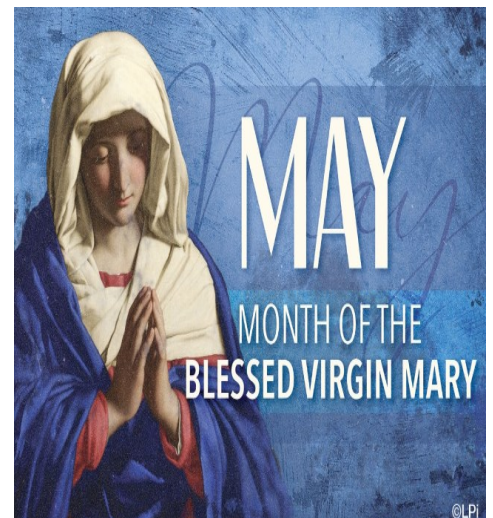

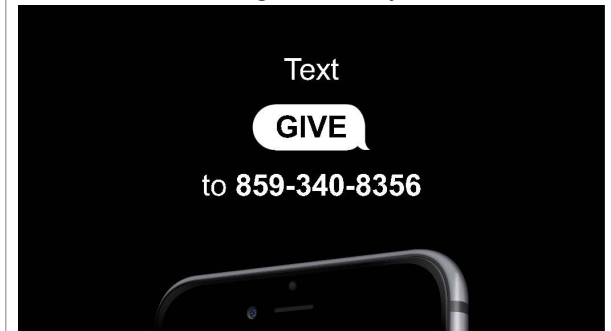

Our pantry is physically located near the elevator in the hallway between the church and school.

It’s impact on those who are in need is an excellent example of the evangelization that Father Jeff talks about that is a pivotal part of our faith journey.

Each month in the bulletin a particular local organization is featured after being selected and contacted to see what items they are needing to help those who come to them.

Sometimes it’s food, sometimes it’s socks, or items for a new baby.

Or as a parish evangelist or missionary?

How about just thinking of yourself as gifted. Every one is gifted by the Holy Spirit in a unique way to build up the Body of Christ.

I love this quote from Lumen Gentium (Light of the World):

“Moreover, the Holy Spirit not only sanctifies and guides God’s people by the sacraments and the ministries, and enriches it with virtues, he also distributes special graces among the faithful of every state of life, assigning his gifts *to each as he chooses*. By means of these special gifts he equips them and makes them eager for various activities and responsibilities that benefit the Church in its renewal or its increase, in accordance with the text: *To each is given the manifestation of the Spirit for a good purpose*.

These charisms, the simpler and more widespread as well as the most outstanding, should be accepted with a sense of gratitude and consolation, since in a very special way they answer and serve the needs of the Church.”

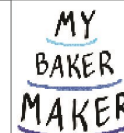
