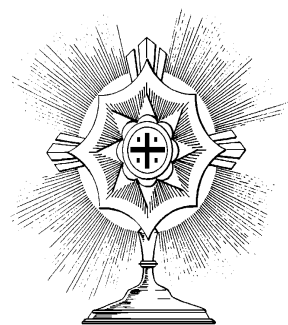

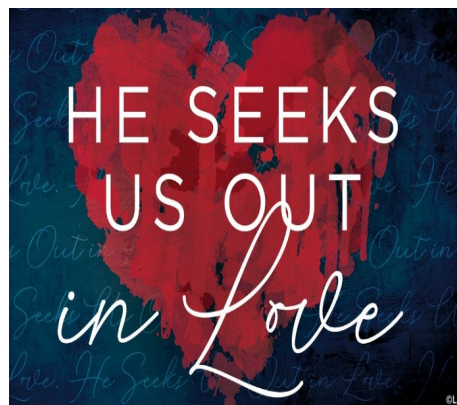
**Ladies Altar Society** meets 7pm every 4th Tuesday each month in the Parish Hall.

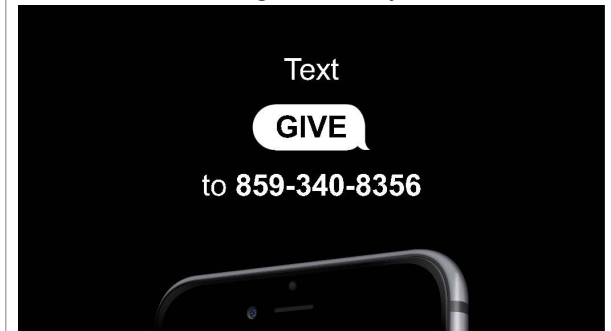

**Important VIRTUS information for all active users-** Thank you for being such a wonderful help to our parish in whatever way you serve! Here are a few things to keep in mind to 'help us help you' keep your account in active status:

The following **must** be done every **five years** to stay in compliance.

Please check your account and make sure you are up-to-date:

- Background Check
- VIRTUS Acceptance Form
- Training
- Do **not** attempt to submit a background check using a cell phone or iPad. It will not process correctly. Please use a computer or laptop to submit a background check.
- Bulletins– a new bulletin for you to complete comes out on the first Sunday of every month. You should get a reminder email from VIRTUS to sign in and complete the bulletin. Your account will go into suspension if you have 8+ unread bulletins, and you will not be able to volunteer until the suspension is lifted.  
**You may want to consider setting yourself a reminder in your calendar.**
- Emails– VIRTUS sends you reminder using their email address **system@virtus.org**. This is a mass emailer. Your email system may be sending these emails to your Spam or Junk folders. You might also want to check your email program to see if it can set up a rule for these emails to be sent to your inbox.
