RECENT SCAM INFORMATION

Scammers are impersonating pastors or staff, often requesting financial assistance (like gift cards), using names and sometimes logos that look similar to legitimate communications. They create a sense of urgency or ask for help with a personal or a confidential issue. They ask for gift cards, money, or other forms of financial assistance, often claiming it's for a specific purpose. Scammers may use email addresses or phone numbers that are similar to legitimate ones to deceive recipients. Look for messages with generic greetings,

missing names, or spelling/grammar errors. Messages asking for specific types of gift cards and the code or PIN, asking for front and back of card sent to them via email.

How to protect yourself and your community:

Verify the Sender: Always contact the pastor or staff member directly through a known official channel to confirm the authenticity of a message.

Be Suspicious: If a message creates a sense of urgency or asks for immediate financial assistance. **Check Email/Text Addresses:** Scammers often use email addresses or phone numbers that are similar to

legitimate ones, so carefully check them.

Suspicious Messages: Do not reply to suspicious messages or provide any personal information.

Report Suspicious Communications: Report to the church office or relevant authorities.

Be Vigilant: Educate yourself and others about the types of scams being used.
