Thus far we have planted peas, spinach, cilantro, onions, radishes, chives, swiss chard and lettuce in the raised beds.

The planting rows have been tilled but will need repeat tilling once the soil dries.

The composting project has yielded a good crop of worms over winter.

Topsoil will be delivered April 11th (weather permitting) and pollination plants will follow. Most crops will go in after Mother's Day to avoid frost bite.

Looking forward to a bountiful harvest and joy as we give witness to God's miracles in His garden. Not only do we cultivate flowers, butterflies, an occasional rabbit in the Patch but friendships flourish as we come together in the garden!

Scott High School will be performing a play in April that addresses what issues teenagers are struggling with, such as depression, anxiety, cutting, bullying, and suicidal thoughts. Scott students play a part in this production. Some students have been acting in the production for many years and continue to come back in hopes of making a difference for someone struggling. LISTENERS NEEDED FOR "DEAD SERIOUS ABOUT LIFE" PLAY

As the "Core Church" we, St. Patrick's, need to provide 15 Listeners and 1 counselor for the listening room after the performances at Scott High School on both Saturday & Sunday. (Five listeners and 1 counselor for each performance.) Listeners will have a 15 minute time slot with a student. It is not a counseling session. It is a time to listen to the student share and get them moving in a "better direction".

- Listeners must be over 18 years of age, love the Lord and like teenagers!

When the listeners arrive at the shows, they need to buy their ticket at the ticket table and get a listening badge from the people at the ticket table.

Our Listening Room coordinators (Tammy or Lisa) will come out and get all the listeners for a brief meeting about 20 minutes BEFORE either show.

She will prepare everyone on what will happen and how to handle things.

Divine Mercy Sunday is a Roman Catholic feast celebrated on the Second Sunday of Easter (the Sunday after Easter Sunday) that focuses on the boundless mercy and love of Jesus Christ. Officially inaugurated by Pope John Paul II in 2000, it stems from the revelations of St. Faustina Kowalska, offering complete forgiveness of sins and punishment (a plenary indulgence) for those who participate in confession and receive Holy Communion worthily on that day.

STORM HEAVEN WITH PRAYERS FOR PEACE

During the Second World War, a group of people stopped whatever they were doing at a specific time every night to pray for peace and safety for everyone. They did this every day, and it was as if the whole city paused — such was the power of prayer. The result was so overwhelming that the bombing stopped shortly afterward!

Now once again some people are organizing.

A group of people around the world has agreed to spend one minute praying for the safety of our countries, for the end of the problems that oppress us, and for God to guide the decisions of our leaders.

We will gather (in our hearts) at the following times:

United States – 1:00 p.m.

Please support us in this initiative. Every day we will pause for one minute at the designated time to pray

for world peace, for the end of conflict, and for the restoration of calm and security for all people on earth. We will also pray that families may seek their security, protection, and salvation in God.

If we truly understood the immense power of prayer, we would be amazed. 🙏🙏🙏🙏

Set an alarm on your phone every day at the time designated for your country and pray for one minute for peace. 🙏🙏🙏🙏

The power of many people praying together at the same time is incredible!
