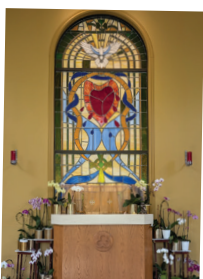

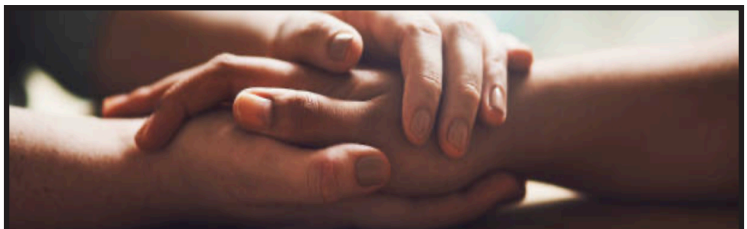

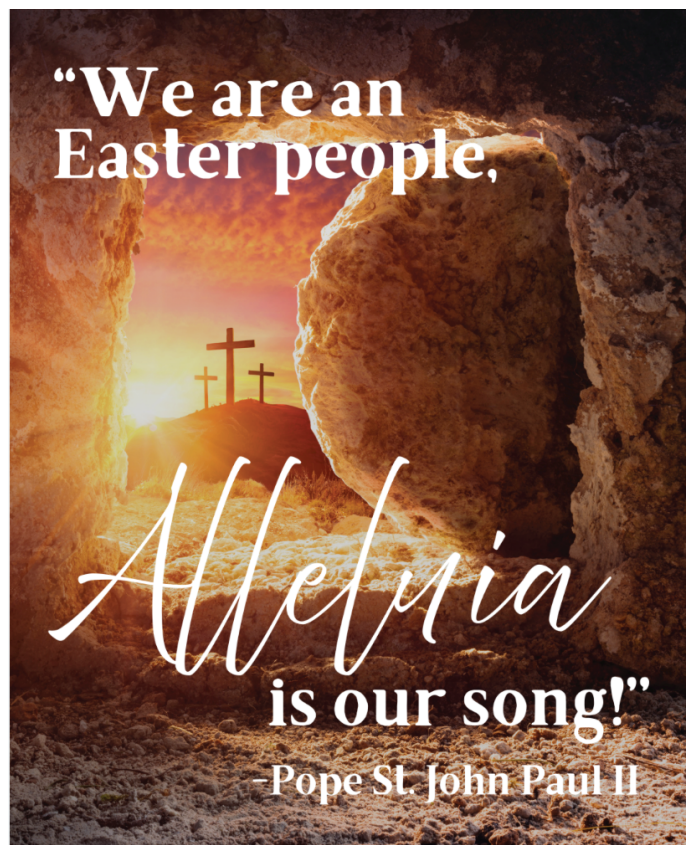
PRAYER LIST INFORMATION

SEE others thru Risen Love (capital L)

(the work of an active contemplative)

First and foremost
I see the person in front of me

Not an abstraction

Not a label
Not a stereotype
Not one on right or left or
Placed in a particular ideology
Not as less or more colored
Less or more human

First and foremost,
I see the person in front of me
With built-in dignity

Don't get me wrong,
There is certainly truth and lie
Right and wrong, good and evil

There is most certainly Absolute Good or
There could be no good at all

And if no Absolute Good, then everything is permissible -
dehumanizing according to wisdom and philosophy

And because there is Absolute Good, there is
Basic good in us all.

For this reason I can even begin to see the basic good in
the person in front of me

It is most certainly there - his or her dignity
The Absolute good built into their being

it is a good but concealed or else how can a person
misperceive me or me misperceive them?
Or worst of all, I misperceive myself

St. Augustine is right on this point, I think, to call it
"original wound."

But as far as being with this person in front of me, this
person is subject not object.
Basic good, basic being,

But yes, wounded,
Aren't we all?
Judge human acts, we must
But not the person

History reveals every tribe and nation has added to the
wound.

"Who hasn't sinned, cast the first stone?" As it has
been written.

That's authentic history, perhaps summed up in one
line? Judge for yourself. Think for yourself

Respond not react

Martin Luther King Jr had it right, we all are brother and
sisters in a system within the system

shame or human judgement / condemnation is never
the end game
But wholeness, holiness perhaps.

I see the person in front of me as part of the system
within the system

But to destroy everything and start over in a revolt?
that would deny the system within the system, so it
would seem!

It starts with one person seeing the person right in front
of them , a subject not an object.

How Now? You or I ask?
if I enter beyond a monologue where I hear only myself
thinking or talking

Into a dialogue, between the person in front of me and I
myself

So much so, we understand each other,
Then I begin see the person in front of me

still more though, there remains blind spots on both
sides.

What now ?
Turn up the Light !
A triologue

In a Trialogue,
In the transcendence
Rising above both views , without destroying both sides
or both people

But purifying Love, Absolute Goodness,
Calling for inner transformation of heart.

I have to confess now,
I say this Love
Is God,
God's Heart,

Light from Light
Jesus Crucified
And Risen love

Thru Spirit, Sacrament and Word, growing the system
within the system

In order to truly see the person right in front of me as
subject not as object whether believer or not

But I never impose only propose,

Crucified Love affirms the dignity in the person right
before me, and the dignity in me as well.

The dignity is of the Father revealing His Heart,
Who never stops thinking of the person right in front of
me, nor of me,

From before time, both of us have our dignity from a
Heavenly Father who never stops thinking of you or me ,
God made, not human made,
Not "my body, my choice"

So much more than that, chosen, made in love
Your body, my body as God 's Sacred Temple,
The person in front of me is Temple of Holy Spirit
Whether handicapped or mentally or emotionally
challenged and who isn't?

Whether old or young, premie /pre born
Sick or ill,
Rich or poor,
Enemy or friend

We are all called to come thru the Open Door,
Of His Heart.
Into the system within the system, the interior kingdom
of God
As the person you and I are truly in His firm but gentle
Eyes

This is how I see the person in front of me
Especially in his or her suffering
if I can move from monologue to dialogue to Trialogue.

I see Christ in the person in front of me

It is human,
It is reasonable
It is intelligent
It is Wisdom from above
It is Christian love,
It is Beauty, the catholic way of life and seeing
It is Good News

This is path to peace.
Share it, if you can

How I see the person in front of me
starts in my own heart

Never imposed only proposed

Think for yourself,
each person received from above
Above the social media and man made social constructs
From monologue to dialogue to trialogue
The system within the system

First and foremost, To see others thru Risen Love

Where the true, beautiful and good has been buried
