EXPLANATION OF DPAA ANNUAL APPEAL

Did you know, the DPAA also benefits us if we go over the required amount the diocese has assigned to St. Pat's? Some of the items we have purchased in the past because we have gone above the amount have been a new roof, new chairs for the hall...we are now in need of repair of the front steps, where these extra funds could be used.

The Diocesan Parish Annual Appeal (DPAA) is a yearly charity and teamwork program. It is *required* of all churches in our diocese. Imagine it like a giant church piggy bank. Families all over your local area put amounts of money into it. Together, these gifts add up to help people in big ways. The DPAA works through a simple, four-step mission:

Helping Others: Money goes to Catholic Charities to buy food for the hungry, give warm coats to those without homes, and help families going through hard times.

Supporting Schools: Helps pay for books, teachers, and classroom supplies so kids can go to Catholic schools.

Caring for Priests: Helps take care of older, retired priests who spent their whole lives helping others.

Training New Priests: Pays for the education of new helpers and priests who are learning how to lead the church.

Whenever people give to the DPAA, they are acting as the "hands and feet" of Jesus by sharing love with their neighbors.

The DPAA is required of all parishes, if we do not make the amount appointed by the diocese we then have to give the additional money from our own pocket we use for running Saint Pat's.

Our church has been asked to give \$61,400.00 to help in the mission of the church.

We are at 89% of our goal, as of this posting we have \$54,446 in donations!

All money that goes over this amount will come back directly to us for anything we feel needed at our own parish. Be it \$1 or \$1000, that money is St. Pat's to do

Today is the Solemnity of Corpus Christi or, in English, the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. Happy feast day! Today is the solemn commemoration of the institution of the Holy Eucharist at the Last Supper. It is, moreover, the Church's official act of homage and gratitude to Christ, who by instituting the Holy Eucharist gave to the Church her greatest treasure. Here's a beautiful personal reflection upon today's feast by Jeremy Priest, Director of the Office of Worship for the Diocese of Lansing.

"Amazement! How on earth can it be that Jesus Christ is not only with us through the outpouring of the Holy Spirit, but that through that same Spirit, his Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity is with us in the Most Holy Sacrament of the Altar?!"

"The Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi) is celebrated each year because of this awestruck wonder — God continues to dwell among us and gives Himself to us in His Body and Blood! Not that we don't know this wonderful gift every Sunday — for some of us, even daily! — but the feast of Corpus Christi is like a yearly birthday by which we remember and recall how amazing it is that God dwells among us in this way!"

"Corpus Christi is the acknowledgement that the Lord Jesus, God become man, is our companion through the days of the year in the



Blessed Sacrament. The word companion comes from a combination of the Latin words, cum, meaning with, and panis, meaning bread. So, the Blessed Sacrament is literally, "bread with us." With St. Augustine, Pope Benedict XVI helps us to deepen our amazement."

"St Augustine helps us to understand the dynamic of Eucharistic communion when he mentions a sort of vision that he had, in which Jesus said to him: "I am the food of strong men; grow and you shall feed on me; nor shall you change me, like the food of your flesh into yourself, but you shall be changed into my likeness" (Confessions, vii, 10, 18)."

Meanwhile, Pope Benedict XVI writes: "Therefore, I whereas food for the body is assimilated by our organism and contributes to nourishing it, in the case of the Eucharist it is a different Bread: it is not we who assimilate it but it assimilates us in itself, so that we become conformed to Jesus Christ, a member of his Body, one with him. This passage is crucial. In fact, precisely because it is Christ who, in Eucharistic communion changes us into him, our individuality, in this encounter, is opened, liberated from its egocentrism and inserted into the Person of Jesus who in his turn is immersed in Trinitarian communion."
