### PADRE'S PATCH

As of this week there is still approximately one row available for planting. I have reserved basil plants for the tomato rows; basil acts as a deterrent against pest invasion.

Issues: Weeds, Poison Ivy, Communication We are still in need of volunteers for de-weeding. Rainfall has been consistent thus promoting weed growth. The following day is a great time to get to the root of the problem. Any weeds that have not flowered can be put in the left side of the compost bin.

Additionally, poison ivy is growing along the fence line. I am spraying with a mixture of Dawn- Vinegar- Salt which can be found next to the yellow bin in a plastic sprayer. Please be careful. I will tie ribbons on the fence line where poison ivy is growing.

Dear Graduates,

Congratulations on your achievement! You have worked hard, grown in wisdom and taken real steps toward maturity. But this moment is not just about what you have completed — it is about who you are becoming.

As you graduate, I would like you to remember one simple truth — your life is a calling.

When we hear the word “calling,” many people think first of a career or a particular job. Those matter — but God’s calling is bigger than that. Your vocation is not just about what you will do; it is about how you will live and whom you will serve.

God did not create you by accident. Your gifts, your questions, even your struggles are part of the way He calls you to serve the world. Wherever you go next — to high school, college, work, military service or something not yet clear — God is not waiting at the finish line. And remember this: God’s call is never withdrawn. Even if you stumble, even if you wander, God does not stop calling you by name. The Church will always be here to help you hear that voice again — in the Eucharist, in prayer and in the community of believers.

Graduates, the world needs what God has placed within you. Trust that your life has meaning, your choices matter, and your future is held in God’s hands. May you listen carefully, respond generously and live your calling with courage.

### TAKE UP YOUR CROSS

In Catholic teaching, "take up your cross" refers to the call to accept the daily sacrifices, hardships, and sufferings encountered while following Jesus Christ. It involves dying to one's own selfish desires, standing firm in faith despite opposition, and actively aligning one's will with God's will. The Meaning of the Cross Denying Yourself: It requires giving up self-centeredness and submitting to God rather than seeking worldly success or comfort. Active Sacrifice: It means choosing to love, forgive, and serve others, even when it is difficult or requires personal sacrifice. Passive Acceptance: It involves gracefully accepting the burdens, trials, and difficulties (such as relational struggles or persecution for one's faith) that one encounters in life. The Call of Discipleship In the Gospels (such as Matthew 16:24 and Luke 9:23), Jesus states, "If anyone wishes to come after me, he must deny himself and take up his cross daily and follow me." This is a fundamental condition for being a disciple. It emphasizes that Christianity is not about avoiding pain, but rather uniting personal suffering with Christ's sacrifice on the cross. Redemptive Suffering Central to Catholic theology is the concept of redemptive suffering. Because Jesus transformed the cross from a symbol of Roman execution into a symbol of ultimate love and salvation, Catholics believe that any suffering willingly united with Christ takes on a holy purpose. These difficulties can be offered up for the salvation of souls, personal spiritual growth, and the benefit of the Church.

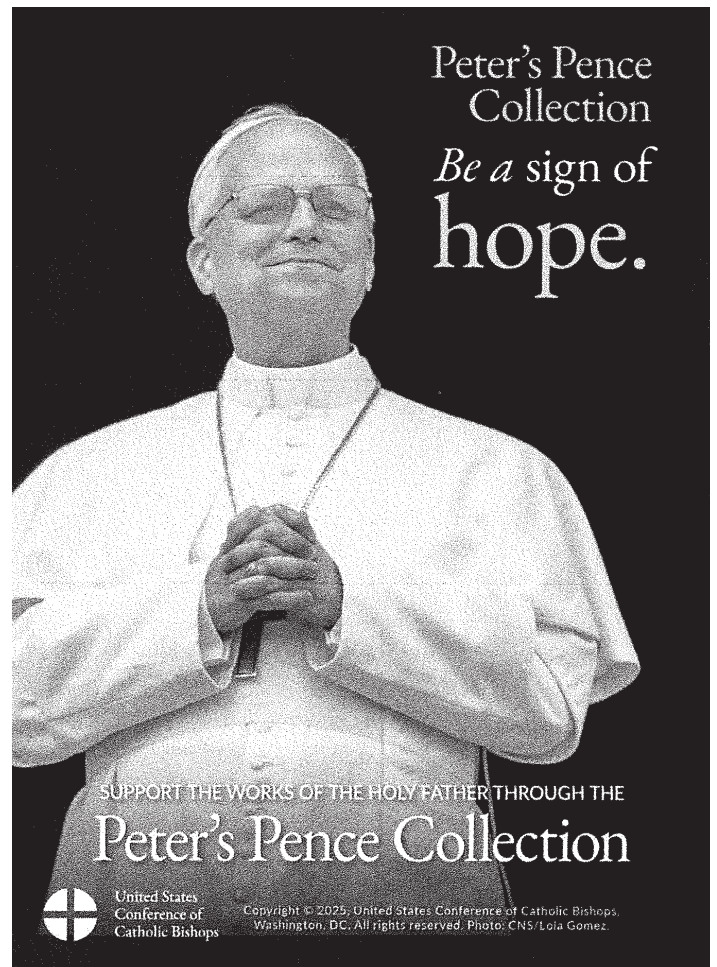
