Increasing conversions and reversions of young adults to our Catholic faith are being reported across the US and the world! Let's be a part of this growing movement!

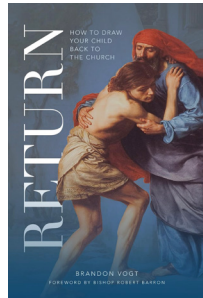

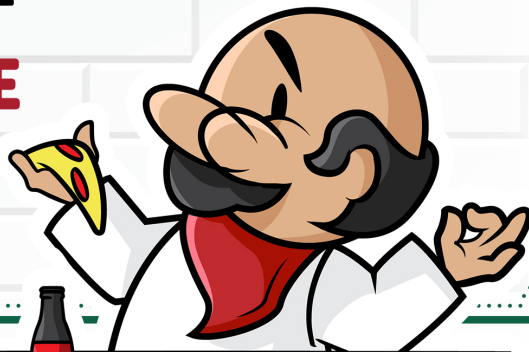

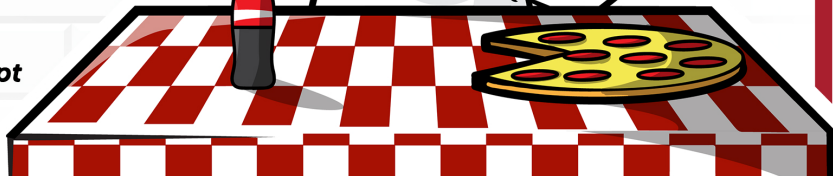

Per a request from USCCB President Archbishop Timothy Broglio, Bishop John Iffert has instructed parishes of the Diocese of Covington to conduct a second collection to provide humanitarian relief and pastoral support to our brothers and sisters in need in Gaza.
