Grief Support Group

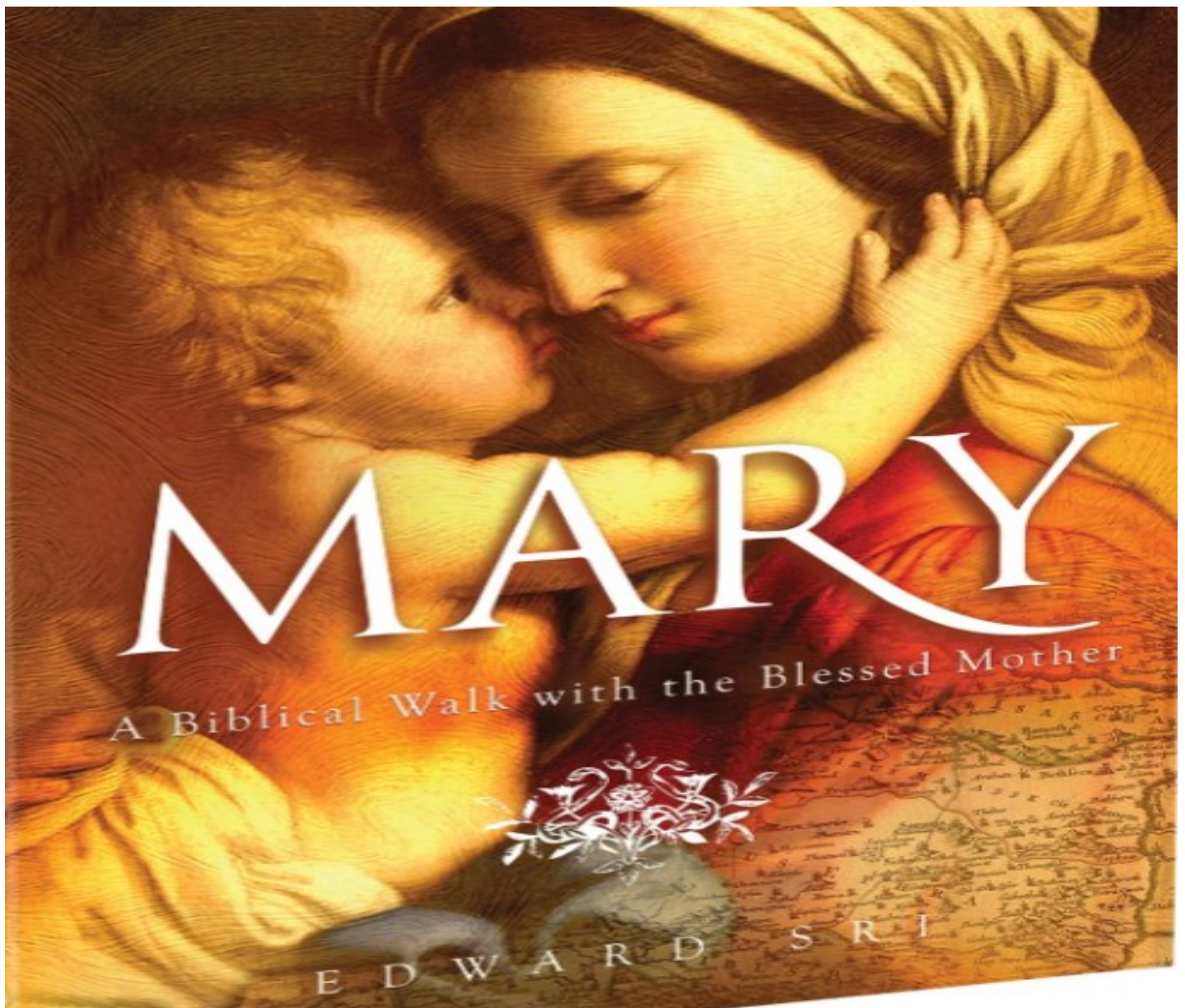

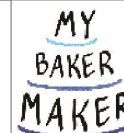
