Let's Accelerate The Return Of Young Adults Back To Church.

I am excited to hear and see reports of increasing conversions and reversions of young adults across the US and the world to our Catholic Church! Praise God! We offer you the opportunity to participate in and contribute to this growing movement in a tangible way! Our PMD Laity Group, in concert with members of Mother of God parish, will be hosting a 6 session workshop at Bishop Howard Memorial Hall this Fall during which participants will learn from experts and each other how to, and how not to, bring those we love back to our faith. The discussions will be guided by the content of the book **Return** by Word on Fire's Brandon Vogt. We will also benefit from the practical expertise of Catholic counselors Dr. Greg and Lisa Popcak shared in their book **Having Meaningful (Sometimes Difficult) Conversations with Your Adult Sons and Daughters**.
